

KNUCKLE LEVER SET 457-103/B

HD REPLACEMENT LEVERS INSTALLATION

Tools & Supplies Needed:

- · Snap Ring remover
- · Phillips Screwdriver
- Flat Blade Screwdriver
- ½" Open Box Wrench

Install Brakelever

- 1. Remove snap ring and pivot pin from stock lever.
- 2. Remove stock lever from housing.
- 3. You can use the nylon bushing as installed in the Highway Hawk lever.
- 4. Place lever back into control housing and replace pivot pin and snap ring.

Install Clutch Lever

- 1. Loosen the clutch tension nuts located at the lower end of the clutch cable, so that the stock clutch lever can be removed.
- 2. Remove snap ring and pivot pin holding the clutch lever in place.
- 3. Pull clutch lever from housing.
- 4. To remove cable from stock lever, push the plastic pin out and replace into Highway Hawk lever.
- 5. Place the Highway Hawk clutch lever, with cable attached, back into the hand control and secure with pivot pin and snap ring.
- 6. Tighten the tension on the clutch cable and adjust as needed.

*NOTE: Always test Brake and Clutch operation before riding.

You should expect tiny blemishes or scratches on chrome. Chrome platers can only strive for perfection. Once a week, or after every ride, use a good chrome cleaner to remove road dirt and other contaminants to help protect your chrome.
